**COST OF SERVICES STUDY PUBLIC OUTREACH MEETINGS

The meetings will be held on Monday, October 24, at 6:30 p.m. at the Cameron Park Community Services District located at 2502 County Club Drive in Cameron Park and on Wednesday, October 26, at 6:30 p.m. at the Pollock Pines-Camino Community Center located at 2675 Sanders Drive in Pollock Pines.
