2008 ULTRA LOW FLOW TOILET -OR- HIGH EFFICIENCY TOILET REBATE APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR A REBATE (credit or check):

1. New construction projects and room additions are NOT eligible for this rebate.
2. Replace a high-flush volume, pre-1992 toilet with a new ultra low flow toilet (ULFT) using 1.6 gallons per flush (gpf); or a high efficiency toilet (HET) using 1.28 gpf or less.
3. The new ULFT/HET model must be installed at a location served by the El Dorado Irrigation District or the City of Placerville (water or water and sewer service).
4. The building must have been built prior to January 1, 1992.
5. The new ULFT/HET model must replace a 3.5, 5, or 7 or more gallon per flush toilet.
6. The old high flow toilet(s) must be properly disposed of, which is the responsibility of the applicant.
7. The new ULFT/HET model must be purchased after January 1, 2008 to be eligible for this rebate (credit or check).

PROCEDURE TO RECEIVE A REBATE (credit or check):

1. Purchase and install a new ULFT or HET model using 1.6 gallons per flush (gpf) or less.
2. Properly dispose of your old toilet as required. Disposal of used fixtures is the responsibility of the applicant.
3. To avoid delays, fully complete and return this signed application and customer survey, along with the original dated sales receipt, to the EID Office of Water Efficiency at 2890 Mosquito Road, Placerville, CA, 95667.
4. If you would like your original receipt returned, please include a self-addressed envelope.

Rebate credit or check: Eligible customers that receive their water or water and sewer bills directly from EID will receive a rebate by credit on their EID account. Eligible customers that do NOT receive a water or water and sewer bill from EID – customers with the City of Placerville, customers residing in mobile home parks, and customers receiving bills indirectly from a third party such as property managers, homeowner associations, and landlords – will receive a rebate by check.

Rebate amount (credit or check): Residential rebates of up to \$125 - up to the retail cost, whichever is less - will be issued for the purchase of ULFT models. Residential rebates of up to \$175.00 - up to the retail cost, whichever is less - will be issued for the purchase and installation of HET models. For commercial, industrial or institutional customers only, the rebates are up to \$300 for the purchase of ULFT or HET models.

Verification of Installation: EID reserves the right to inspect, and/or verify onsite, the installation of any Ultra Low Flow Toilet or High Efficiency Toilet submitted for this rebate program.

Duration: The start date for the 2008 Ultra Low Flow Toilet or High Efficiency Toilet Rebate program is January 1, 2008. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. EID in its discretion may at any time change this program without prior notice.

Disclaimers: EID reserves the right to deny any application that does not meet all the requirements outlined above. Due to variables beyond the control of EID and the City of Placerville, the District and the City cannot guarantee that the installation of high efficiency or ultra low flow toilets will result in lower utility bills. EID is not responsible for damage that occurs to any person, or real or personal property as a result of the program. This program is designed to provide financial assistance to EID and City of Placerville customers wishing to replace older, high water use toilets with water conserving toilets in their homes. Installation of toilets is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is the determination of the adequacy and compatibility of their existing plumbing system. EID and the City of Placerville assume no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this rebate program.

Limitation of Liability/Release: Applicant understands and agrees that to, the extent not prohibited by law, in no event shall EID, its officials, officers, employees or agents be liable for any claimed or actual damages or losses of any kind, however caused and regardless of the theory of liability, related in any way to this ULFT/HET replacement program, even if EID has been advised of the possibility of such damages or losses. To the extent not prohibited by law, applicant assumes all risks associated with this program, including without limitation, all risks associated with installation and operation of the ULFT/HET provided hereunder and the risk of not realizing cost savings as a result of using the ULFT/HET. Applicant releases EID its officials, officers, employees and agents from any and all claims for damage or death or injury to any persons or property arising in any way from this ULFT/HET replacement program or any ULFT/HET provided hereunder, including without limitation installation or use thereof, other than those caused solely by the willful or grossly negligent acts or omission of EID.
